

## Behaviour Management Event

## Friday 23rd Nov 2018, The Hive, University of Worcester

## **Event Description:**

Managing challenging and unorthodox behaviour in academic environments is becoming increasingly common and a significant part of the day-to-day responsibilities of University staff. This is no exception for library staff who often encounter challenging behaviour from their customers relating to a number of different issues. How we manage this behaviour is key in providing an excellent standard of customer service, and in providing and maintaining a safe and comfortable environment for all library users to work and study.

But how do we defend this vulnerable environment from the threats that seek to penetrate it? How can we empower our teams feel confident to simultaneously tackle challenging behaviour while continuing to provide a supportive, nurturing environment?

This event is designed to share some of the current behaviour issues that we as libraries face on a regular basis and to give us all an opportunity to reflect on our current practices. There will also be an opportunity to share practices as a group and to contribute inspiring new ideas for dealing with behaviour management.

The event will include the following sessions:

- "Space Management issues in University Libraries" Warwick University
- "Behaviours and Safeguarding: the responsibilities of a combined library" University of Worcester
