- City Rooms: Pay for access to whole facilities. About 200. All inclusive. Price/delegate included food refreshments etc.
- Belmont Hotel: Similar price range and facilities slightly more than city rooms
- Cheapest about 2.5k
- o Devonshire Place: Cost 2385 for 90 delegates (plus 26quid booking feed)
- DMU: Free venue, up to 200 delegates. Won't be charged for venue due to
 DMU staff membership of Mercian. Need to arrange our own insurance
- UoL: 30quid+Vat/welfare plus 100quid for each breakout room (2,880)
