

Mercian Collaboration Development Officer

Update report to Steering Group, 1st December 2020

Since the October Board meeting, the Officer's focus has continued on his usual activities supporting the subgroups, coordinating activities and communications for the Collaboration, and resolving issues as they arise. Preparations, outcomes and support for various meetings, have also accounted for a large portion of the Officer's working schedule over this period. Frequent conversations with the chairs and officers of the Conference and Staff Development Group have continued to be a particular focus over this period, along with periodic exchanges with the Collaboration's Vice Chair.

Interactions with SCONUL staff have continued clarifying matters of mutual concern, notably relating to finance matters. Regular engagement with other regional collaboration officers/managers on topics of mutual concern, interest and information have also been a regular feature of this period. Additionally, in his continued absence of the post holder, the Officer has continued to act as de facto Treasurer for the organisation, monitoring expenditure in cooperation with SCONUL Accounts.^{III}

Reporting

Outline drafting of the 2020 annual report and preparations for the 2021 Steering Group elections, including updating documentation, have been made over this period. A number of timely updates to the website's structure and content have also been made, notably refining elements of it in terms of accessibility and layout. Information on forthcoming events on the site have been regularly updated, along with monthly publication of the Mercian Newsletter on the open discussion list promoting our activities. Additionally, the Officer provided outline modelling for 2021 subscription models and group membership for consideration by the Board, along with salary expectation modelling for the Vice-Chair.
